She believed that if people did not take responsibility then the un-owned negativity would be projected out into the world and would create strife because all thought becomes form somewhere.

In her Life, Death, Transition Workshops she encouraged people to "own up", to share their dark side, share the mistakes that haunted them, or whatever it was that continued to cause torment in their lives; to get it out in the open where it would lose its power to control the life with feelings of shame, hate, revenge, and bitterness and instead, create peace on the inside. What a relief!
